* The school received Pupil Premium funding for 47 pupils who were on-role and eligible in June 2016. The remaining pupils either joined the school or became eligible for Free School Meals after this date.

Nature of Support provided by the Pupil Premium Grant

- One to one and small group tuition
- Mentoring support
- Educational visits
- Education equipment
- Music lessons

Given the relatively small number of pupils receiving Pupil Premium funding we are able to consider each individual and target support where it provides the most benefit. The impact of all such support is evaluated as part of the school's on-going attainment and value-added analysis.

Nature of Support provided by the Sixth Form Bursary

- Home to school transport costs
- Uniform
- Educational visits
- Educational equipment
- School meals
- University visits

Pupils in Years 12 and 13 apply for bursary funding, providing details of requirements and proof of their household income. All applications are considered on an individual basis by the Bursary Committee who meet regularly.

Once the application is approved payment is made, either directly for the item requested or by BACS to the pupil, and receipts are requested for all purchases.
