- **18.9% of all entries were graded A* (the national average was 8%)**
- **49.0% of all entries were graded A* or A (the national average was 26.2%)**
- **We continue to be one of the top state schools for numbers going on to Oxbridge**
- **The large majority of our students go on to attend their first choice University, most of which are Russell Group Universities**
