



# Remote Home Learning Information – Jan/Feb 2021

General points:



- All students will follow their timetable in real time
- Each lesson will contain some live or recorded content at the professional discretion of the staff
- Google Classroom and Google Meet will be the main platforms for learning
- Google Meets will have a maximum of 40-minute duration. Some Google Meets (intro/plenary) may only be five minutes
- School timings revert to original timings of the School Day (8.45 Tutor Period, 9.10 Period One, 10.10 Period Two, 11.10 Break, 11.35 Period Three, 12.35 Period Four, 1.35 Lunch, 2.35 Period Five)
- Protocols for Remote Home Learning to be followed – including cameras being on in Google Meets to maximise engagement and assessment of learning

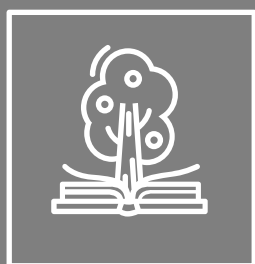
- Students will learn by engaging in the Remote Home Learning Procedure
- We will continue to follow the same curriculum as we do in School
- Assessment and Feedback procedures will remain in place and follow existing whole School and department specific policies
- A tutor period will take place every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 8.45am. Form tutors will also use Google Meet
- PSHE will be set via the tutor



## All Year Groups

- From 11 January 2021 students will follow their timetable in real time with staff providing learning as above
- In Year 7-9: No extra homework will be set at this time up to 12 February 2021.
- In Years 10/11: Homework may be set to fulfil curriculum demands.
- In Year 12/13: Homework, consolidation, subject reading and enrichment will be set to fulfil curriculum demands and utilise study periods

- Key worker, disadvantaged and vulnerable students from all year groups will continue to be invited into School
- Students with SEND will be contacted by the Student Support Team and provided bespoke support
- For a place as a Key Worker student, please complete the Google Form sent to parents or email the School Office
- Students complete their learning using the Remote Home Learning Procedure. This may be supplemented by enrichment activities
- From 5 January 2021, this group of students do not need to wear School uniform
- All students have been contacted in relation to support required to access Remote Home Learning. Support is available with loanable Chromebooks and support for online access
