Learning and Teaching





- **Digital Learning** – With the success of Remote Home Learning and the continued development in the use of Google Classroom, we are exploring the potential for Chromebook adoption across the School, with a trial completed in Lee 7 in the summer term 2021. More information will follow.
- **Webcams** – Webcams will remain in classrooms to facilitate learning for any students required to isolate.

School Operations

- **Break and Lunch** – We will revert to common break and lunch times from September. This is to facilitate the return of clubs and practices at lunch, and pastoral / well-being advantages at break.
- **Movement Time** – The introduction of movement time has had a positive impact on learning in the one-hour lessons. Whilst ten minutes (currently) is too long, we will maintain a five-minute movement between periods 1/2 and periods 3/4.
- **Timings of the School Day** – In conjunction with break, lunch, and movement time changes, we are proposing to adopt new timings for the school day. We will aim to start five minutes earlier at 8:40am, reducing lunch by five minutes to end at 3.35pm to facilitate home-school transport.

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- **One-Way System** – The one-way system enabled an orderly and more calm route around the School. The full system is no longer required, but we will maintain three one-way loops (Main Corridor/English/Music/HM Quad, Tower Block/Geography/Maths, HM Quad/Hall/LT/Sixth Form/Science). The system will be active during all lesson change overs.
- **Lockers** – From September, lockers will be re-issued for student use
- **Tutor Room Locations** – Tutor rooms will be grouped by Year Group, rather than House (as in previous years). This has had a positive impact on pastoral care and behaviour management. This may facilitate some movement of lockers.
- **Hand Sanitiser** – These will remain in classrooms and around the School.
- **Emergency Evacuation** – The procedures will see a permanent change with Years 7-11 congregating on the School field, Years 12-13 on the main playground. Updated procedures will be sent separately.
- **Bag drop areas** – One aspect of staggered break/lunch has been the relatively lower impact of bags around the dining hall doorways. This problem does persist, and we will mark bag drop areas for clarity and safety.
- **Dining Hall organisation** – We will retain the central barrier for the time being. At break Year 7-9 to access on the Old Gym side and Year 10-11 on the car park side. Priority will be given to Year 7 up to October half term. Lunch time will be split with hot food on one side and grab 'n go on the other.



Calendar and Events

- **Parents' Consultation Evenings** – After the success of online consultation evenings from staff and parent feedback, all future meetings will be run as an online event.
- **Parents' Information Evenings** – These evenings will return to face-to-face events to ensure parental engagement.
- **Assemblies** – Assemblies will return to face-to-face events. Each section will organise single year group assemblies or section assemblies
