CAREERS EDUCATION

- From year 7-13 students are involved in careers related activities during extended registration periods a minimum of once a half term and scheduled as part of **Personal Development** once a year. In these sessions students, access careers profiles, post-18 options information and labour market information and develop a careers activities and skills profile via the **Unifrog** platform.
- Careers Education is embedded in the curriculum with many departments covering the careers pathways allowed by their subject in standalone lessons, classwork and homework tasks.
