- 77 students (over a third of the year) gained at least 3 A grades with 55 students gaining all A* and A grades
- 21% of all entries were graded A* (the national average was 8.6%)
- 53% of all entries were graded A* or A (the national average was 26.5%)
- We continue to be one of the top state schools for numbers going on to Oxbridge
- The large majority of our students go on to attend their first choice University, most of which are Russell Group Universities
