- 99.5% of students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at grades 9 4
- 78% of students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at grades 9 7
- 45% of all entries were graded 9-8 (the National average was 12%)
- AGS students were over 4 times more likely to achieve a grade 9 than students nationally
- Average points per GCSE entry was 7.2 (where 9 = 9, 8 = 8 etc)
