- 77 students (over 35% of the year) gained at least 3 A grades with 45 students gaining all A* and A grades
- 15% of all entries were graded A* (the national average was 9.4%)
- 41% of all entries were graded A* or A (the national average was 28.1%)

- The large majority of our students go on to attend their first choice University, most of which are Russell Group Universities
